NO.UDD 536 MNY 2014, BENGALURU, DATED: 01-02-2018.

Whereas, the draft of the Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike (Recruitment of Poura Karmikas) (Special) Rules, 2017 was published as required by sub-section (1) of section 421 of the Karnataka Municipal Corporations Act, 1976 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1977) in Notification No. UDD 536 MNY 2014, dated: 18.08.2017 in Part-IVA of the Karnataka Gazette, No. 786, dated: 18.08.2017 inviting objections and suggestions from all the persons likely to be affected thereby within fifteen days from the date of its publication in the official Gazette.

And whereas, the said Gazette was made available to the public on 18.08.2017.

And whereas, objections and suggestions have been received in this behalf and considered by the Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 89 and 91 read with section 421 of the Karnataka Municipal Corporations Act, 1976 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1977) the Government of Karnataka hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

RULES

1. Title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike (Recruitment of Poura Karmikas) (Special) Rules, 2017.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their final publication in the official Gazette.

(3) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Karnataka Civil Services (General Recruitment) Rules, 1977 or in the city of Bengaluru Municipal Corporation Services (General) Cadre and Recruitment Regulations, 1971 or in any other rules of recruitment relating to the categories of posts specified in the schedule made or deemed to have been made, under the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) and the Karnataka Municipal Corporations Act, 1976 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1977) the provisions of these rules shall apply to recruitment of 4000 posts direct recruitment vacancies in the categories of posts of Pourakarmikas in the Municipal Corporations Services as specified in the schedule:

Provided that, nothing in these rules shall apply to more than one recruitment.

2. Definitions.- (1) In these regulations unless the context otherwise requires,-

(a) **'Appointing Authority'** means the Commissioner as specified under regulations 2(c) of the city of the Bengaluru Municipal Corporation Services (General) Cadre and Recruitment Regulations, 1971;

(b) **"Contract Pourakarmikas"** mean who are working in the Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike as NMR / Daily wages/ Contract / out source/ others on who have served for not less than two years and continues to work as such on the date of commencement of these rules.

(c) **'Schedule'** means a Schedule appended to these rules;

(d) **'Selection'** means selection of candidates in accordance with the provisions of these rules;

(e) **'Selection Committee'** means a selection committee constituted under rule 3; and

(f) **'Vacancies'** means the number of vacant posts as specified in the schedule to be filled up under these rules.

(2) Other words and expressions used but not defined in these rules, shall have the same meaning assigned to them in the Bengaluru Municipal Corporation Services (General) Cadre and Recruitment Regulations, 1971.

3. Constitution of Selection Committee.- There shall be constituted a Selection committee for Selection of candidates for recruitment to fill the vacancies specified in the schedule at the Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike level (hereinafter referred to as BBMP) consisting of the following members, namely:-

1	The Special Commissioner (Admin), BBMP.	Chairman
2	The Deputy Commissioner (Admin), BBMP.	Member
3	All Zonal Additional/Joint Commissioners, (including SWM and Health), BBMP.	Members
4	The Assistant Commissioner (Admin-2), BBMP.	Member
5	The Head of the Legal Cell, BBMP	Member
6	The Chief Accounts Officer, BBMP.	Members
7	The Assistant Commissioner (Recruitment and Enquiry), BBMP.	Member Secretary

4. Age limit.- Notwithstanding anything contained in the Karnataka Civil Services (General Recruitment) Rules, 1977 or in the Bengaluru Municipal Corporation Services (General) (Cadre and Recruitment) Regulations, 1971 the maximum age limit shall not be more than forty five years.

5. Method of Recruitment.- (1) The Selection Committee shall, after taking into consideration the vacancies to be filled and classification in accordance with reservation of posts provided by or under any law or any order for the time being in force invite online applications downloading documents as specified in sub-rule (2) from the intended candidates an abstract of such advertisement shall also be published atleast in two daily newspapers having wide circulation in which one shall be in kannada.

(2) The Selection Committee shall from among the candidates who have applied in pursuance to the publication made under sub-rule (1) prepare a selection list in the order of age by treating a person older in age as senior to a person younger in age:

Provided that preference shall be given to persons who are working as NMR/Daily Wages/contract/outsource/others Pourakarmikas who have served continuously for not less than two years in the Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike and continues to work as such on the date of commencement of these rules.

Provided further that, a person who has worked for more number of years shall be preferred against a person who have worked less number of years.

Provided also that, for considering outsourcing Pourakarmikas, there shall be an documentary evidence of having worked and paid for at least two years by the agency of BBMP towards PF, ESI and salary remittance etc., for the NMR/Daily Wages/contract/others there shall be documentary evidence of having worked and paid wages for atleast two years from the BBMP funds.

(3) The number of candidates to be selected under sub-rule (2) shall be equal to the number of vacancies notified.

(4) If the length of service of two or more candidate is equal, then the order of preference in respect of such candidates shall be fixed on the basis of their age, the

older in age being placed above the younger. If the date of birth and service of the candidates is same then the selection is to be by lottery.

(5) The Selection Committee shall also prepare an additional list of such of the candidates not included in the main list prepared under sub-rule (2). The number of candidates to be included in the additional list shall be as far as possible twenty percent of the number of candidates to be selected. There shall be atleast one candidate in the additional list belonging to each of the reservation categories (horizontal and vertical) represented in the list under sub-rule (2) to the extent possible. If a candidate whose name is included in the list under sub-rule (2), fails to report for duty within the prescribed time, to that extent a candidate belonging to the same reservation category as that of the candidate who failed to report for duty shall be appointed from the additional list.

(6) The lists so prepared under sub-rule (2) and (5) shall be published on the notice board of the office of the Commissioner and shall also be intimated to the candidate and published on the respective website of the BBMP.

(7) The List of candidates selected by the Selection Committee and submitted to the Appointing Authority shall be valid till all the notified vacancies are filled or till the completion of six months from the date of publication of the selected list whichever is earlier.

6. Appointment of candidates.- (1) Candidates whose names are included in the selection list prepared under sub-rule (2) of rule 5 shall be appointed by the appointing authority in the vacancies in the order of which their names are found in the list after satisfying itself after such enquiry as it may consider necessary that each of the candidates be suitable in all respects for appointment.

(2) The inclusion of name of a candidate in the list published under sub-rule (6) of rule 5 shall not confer any right of appointment.
