STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

Act 49 of 1981.- Section 3 of the Disturbed Areas (Special Courts) Act, 1976 (Central Act 77 of 1976) provides for declaration of an area as a "disturbed area" if there has been extensive disturbance of the public peace and tranquility because of differences or disputes between the members of different religious, racial, language or regional groups or castes or communities and for setting up of special courts in such area. Since such disturbances could arise for reasons other than those specifically mentioned in the said section 3 it is proposed to empower the State Government to declare an area as disturbed area for any other reason also.

Hence this Bill.

THE DISTURBED AREAS (SPECIAL COURTS) (KARNATAKA AMENDMENT) ACT, 1981.

An Act to amend the Disturbed Areas (Special Courts) Act, 1976 in its application to the State of Karnataka.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Disturbed Areas (Special Courts) Act, 1976 (Central Act 77 of 1976) for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

BE it enacted by the Karnataka State Legislature in the Thirty-second year of the Republic of India as follows :-

1. Short title.- (1) This Act may be called the Disturbed Areas (Special Courts) (Karnataka Amendment) Act, 1981.

2. Amendment of section 3.- In section 3 of the Disturbed Areas (Special Courts) Act, 1976 (Central Act 77 of 1976) in sub-section (1), after the words "castes or communities", the words "or due to any other reason" shall be inserted.
